Update on Covid-19 guidance - 30.11.21

Following the latest government update confirming the new Omicron variant, we'd like to remind you of the Covid-19 safety measures that we have in place.

We can confirm that there is **no immediate change** to our teaching approach and face-to-face teaching will continue as planned.

Face coverings

In response to the latest guidance on face coverings, we continue to **firmly recommend** that face coverings are worn (exemptions apply) when travelling around a BPP study centre, and we support and respect those who wish to wear them in all settings. Please work with us and continue to be mindful of other people.

Social distancing

Please maintain as much social distancing as you can whilst travelling around the building.

Vaccines

We continue to strongly recommend that you take the opportunity to receive both vaccines. If you have any questions about accessing the vaccine then please visit the MHS Covid-19 vaccination FAQs.

We will continue to implement the following key safety measures within our centres:

- Enhanced frequency of cleaning alongside a dedicated Covid-19 cleaning risk assessment
- Additional handwashing facilities/hand sanitisers at all centres, including at entrances, exits and regular touchpoints
- Wipes and cleaning products at touch points, including printers and computers
- Plexiglass screens at receptions and enquiry desks
- Keeping shared spaces well ventilated

We will continue to review our position in line with Government and HE guidance and will make any necessary adjustments and communicate with you as appropriate.
