

21 September 2021 - Update for Sponsored Students on returning to Face-to-Face Teaching

In line with our transition plan, we have been working hard to prepare to welcome you all back to face-to-face classes this autumn.

We know that everyone has adapted incredibly well to the online environment however, we are a face-to-face institution, and we are therefore expecting to see you back in centre as detailed on your timetable.

Courses have already begun, so please make sure you check your timetable to see when you are expected in-centre. You will have already seen communications about the work BPP has done to ensure both staff and student safety, including the protocols for attending a study centre, so please make sure that you have read those and are well-prepared.

International Students

For existing international students (currently sponsored with a study visa), the final date for transition back to face to face is 27th September. Therefore, if you have decided to relocate to your home country to study, you should be relocating to the UK (including clearing quarantine/isolation) before that date.

Similarly, if you have relocated within the UK you will need to make arrangements to return to accommodation which enables you to access your named campus.

ID verification

It is our responsibility as a sponsor to check your identification. You therefore need to bring your passport into your study centre the first time you come in. We will then check your identity and issue your student ID card. Please note that the ID check is NOT part of the enrolment process and does not change your registration status. This is a separate check required by the Home Office.

When you have your ID card from us, that will serve as proof of identity.

Please plan to come into centre at least 30 minutes before your class starts on the first day in case there is a queue as we will not be able to allow you into classes until this check has been completed.
