Children are generally welcome at your BPP Graduation. However, we would not recommend the event for very young children or babies, as the day can be noisy, long and tiring for them.

Please note:

- Graduands with very young children or babies are encouraged to arrange childcare elsewhere, so they can relax and fully enjoy their special day
- Any children in attendance must be accompanied by an adult family member or guest known to you, in possession of a purchased guest ticket
- Guest seating areas are separate from graduand seating areas, and children must sit with the guest ticket holder for the duration of the ceremony
- Tickets must be purchased for children requiring their own seat, but not for children who can sit on laps
- You cannot walk across the stage with your child or sit with them during the ceremony
- Lifts are available for people with pushchairs
- Please make arrangements prior to the ceremony to ensure that your child remains calm, to prevent disruption
- Should your child become distressed during the ceremony, the person supervising them should remove them to the hallway until they calm down
