Establishing a Student Wellbeing Week, peer support networks, and a clear mental health signposting system so every student knows exactly where to turn when life gets tough.

PRIORITY 04

Inclusion & Community

Growing cross-cultural events, student society collaboration, and a BPP Diversity Calendar to celebrate our community's richness and ensure every student feels they truly belong here.

As President, I will not work alone. I will collaborate with student representatives, the Students' Association team, BPP University staff, and senior leaders to build strong relationships and lead with integrity.
